PASSAGE 1

Read the article about Coco Chanel and do TASK 3 below.

COCO CHANEL



Gabrielle “Coco” Chanel, the famous fashion designer, was born in France in 1883 and died at the age of 87 in Paris, in 1971. She grew up in a very poor family. Her mother was a laundrywoman in a charity hospital and her father was a street salesman. When Chanel’s mother died of tuberculosis, her father sent her and her two sisters to an orphanage.

During the time in the orphanage, Chanel became very good at sewing and fixing clothes. After leaving the orphanage, she found a job as a dressmaker. Later, she began to design hats. She became a professional hat designer in 1910 and opened a boutique in Paris. Her career developed and started to go really well once theatre actress Dorziat wore her hats in a play in 1912.

In 1913, Chanel opened another boutique, where she started selling casual clothes suitable for leisure and sport. Women found her clothes comfortable and elegant. Additionally, her designs broke a gender barrier. For example, in Chanel’s time only men could wear trousers. Thanks to her, it is now acceptable for women to wear trousers.

In the 1920s, she became the top fashion designer in Paris. Soon her name became known all over the world. Chanel designed many clothes that are still fashionable today such as the little black dress, the Breton (striped) top and two-tone flat shoes. In 1922, Chanel introduced her perfume Chanel No 5 which is also popular today.

Chanel started a new way of thinking about fashion. She was so important that she was the only designer named in *Time* magazine’s list of the 100 most influential people of the 20th century.

One of the Romans' favourite activities was watching gladiators' fight. They fought in big stadiums like the Colosseum. Gladiators were usually prisoners or slaves who had to fight. Good gladiators became really well-known, but most of them were killed while they were fighting.



The Romans also adopted a very popular event from the ancient Greeks: the Olympic Games. In ancient Greece, people used to do a lot of sport. The first Olympic Games began 2800 years ago in Greece. There was only one race and all of the athletes were men. Women couldn't go to watch the race because the men didn't wear clothes. The winners never got medals or money. All they got was the honour of winning and the sacred olive tree wreath on the winner's head.
