“*The Seeing Eye*” was founded by two innovative Americans, Dorothy Harrison Eustis and Morris Frank. In the 1920s, Mrs Eustis was living in Switzerland breeding and training German Shepherds for (1) _____ work. It was during this time that she saw something astonishing in Germany. Dogs were being trained to become new eyes for veterans who had (2) _____ their sight in the First World War. Mrs Eustis was so impressed by the (3) _____ of these dogs and by the confidence of their blind owners that she wrote an article about her experience. It was published in the Saturday Evening Post (4) _____ the title: “*The Seeing Eye*”.

Millions read the article but the story could have ended right there if not for Morris Frank, a college (5) _____ and an insurance salesman from Nashville Tennessee. Blind since the age of (6) _____, Frank wrote to Mrs Eustis explaining that he would do anything for one of these dogs.

She invited him to her home in Switzerland where he became the (7) _____ blind American to regain his independence through the help of a dog guide. His success led to a bold (8) _____: an American School that would teach blind people how to achieve the same degree of independence as those with (9) _____ sight. The resulting partnership proved to be unstoppable. Mrs Eustis provided the funding and training while Mr Frank handled recruiting and (10) _____ relations. Within one year they had created a dog guide school they called “*The Seeing Eye*”.
