PRIOR KNOWLEDGE:

Present and Past Tenses

Basic vocabulary to talk about the importance of the English Language in today's world.

PROCEDURE

ACTIVITY 1 – INTRODUCTION

Teacher shows a conversation on PPT. The conversation is in Greek but most of the words are in English. This is done to introduce the topic and show the importance and dominance of the English language in our everyday lives.

Students are asked to comment on it.

- Do you use these words in your everyday speech?
- What does this show regarding the importance of English?
- Do you know any other examples of English words that have substituted Greek words?

DEVELOPMENT

ACTIVITY 2:

Teacher gives out handout and students are asked to read the quote on the handout and comment on what it means.

You are on a student exchange programme and you have been asked to design a poster about the importance of learning English. Teacher asks students to work in pairs to create a poster using the speech bubbles given on the handout.

- When and where do I use English?*
- Why am I learning English?*
- Why is it important to learn English?*

Answers are discussed in class

ACTIVITY 3:

Teacher asks students to open their books on page 59 and look at the three pictures.

- What can you see? –Where would you see the images? –Why do you think they are in English?
- Have you seen any signs in Cyprus that are both Greek and English? Give examples and say why do you think English is so widely used in Cyprus?

Students go through the True/False questions and guess the correct answer before reading the article titled 'The World of English'.

Read article in class and students work independently to decide whether the sentences are true or false. Check answers in class.

ACTIVITY 4 – CLOSURE/QUICK REVIEW

Students are given a handout with signs found in Cyprus. The English translation is wrong and students are asked to work in pairs to find the mistakes and correct them.

FOLLOW UP ACTIVITY/ INDEPENDENT PRACTICE OPPORTUNITIES

Find as many words as you can from your own language (Greek) that are now widely used in English.
