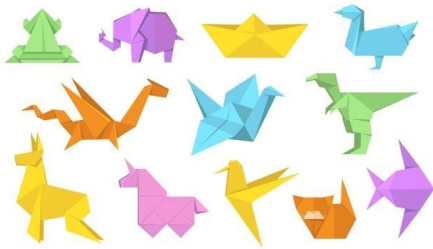

ORIGAMI



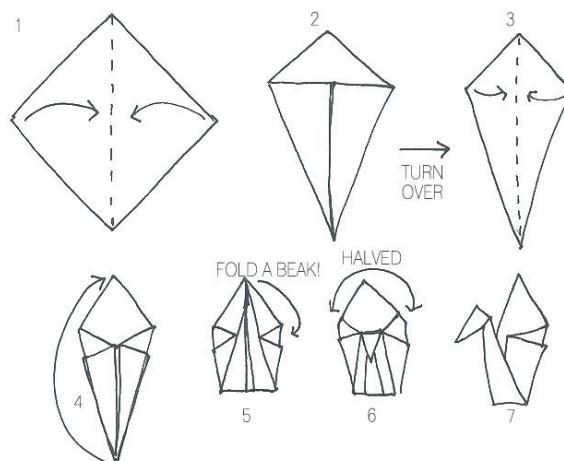
Origami started in China but became very popular in Japan and this is why it is connected with the Japanese culture. It is the art of paper folding. In Japanese, "ori" means folding and "gami" means paper. Today, people use the word "origami" for all folding practices in many cultures all over the world.

What's so great about folding paper? The kind of paper folding we're talking about here is not the same as just folding a piece of paper to fit in your pocket. What we're talking about here is folding paper into birds, butterflies, flowers, dogs, cats, and even Pokémon. The best-known origami model is the Japanese paper crane (a kind of bird). Origami is more than just paper folding. It's paper transforming. It's paper magic. It's art.

Origami can range from the super complicated models to the simple models that are easier to fold. These models need carefully planned folds. In general, these designs begin with a square sheet of paper whose sides may be of different colours, prints, or patterns. Modern origami experts generally discourage the use of cuts, glue, or markings on the paper. There are a few basic origami folds and they can be used in a variety of ways to make complex designs.

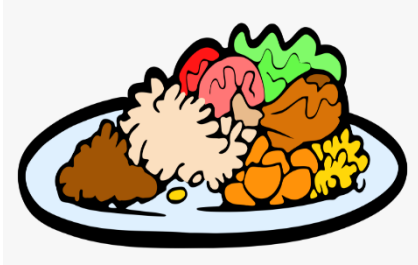
